The guided tour of the exhibition "The Genius of Milan: Crossroads of the Arts from the Middle Ages to the 20th Century" at the Gallerie d'Italia in Piazza della Scala is an opportunity for reflection on the central role that the city of Milan has played over the centuries as a hub for the development of artistic innovations.

The exhibition examines exemplary cases of Milan's key role as a laboratory for new ideas, starting with the Renaissance, marked by the patronage of the Sforza family, under which Leonardo da Vinci worked. His presence in the city left a lasting influence on all Lombard painting in the 16th century. Another case explored is that of Cardinal Federico Borromeo, whose passion for collecting, culminating in the foundation of the Pinacoteca Ambrosiana, spread the interest in landscape and still life genres, as well as in the works of the Flemish masters and Caravaggio.
